Bishop Joseph Durick Assembly #2389 News

I hope everyone had a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year's Day. I pray that God will grant all of us our wishes this coming year.

Although we didn't have a business meeting in the month of December, I did get a request from our District Deputy that was conveyed to him from JP II High School for the Youth 2000 retreat. This retreat will have children from across all of Tennessee, Alabama, Georgia and Mississippi, and there may be children coming from other states as well to participate in this event.

We have a very important request from JP II for this event. JP II is requesting an Honor Guard for the Mass that Bishop Choby will be presiding over. This Mass will be Sunday, February 11, at 10:30 a.m. and the other is an all night Honor Guard for the Eucharistic Adoration. This will be starting on Friday, February 9, 2007 from 9:45 p.m. ending on Saturday, February 10, 2007, 8:00 a.m. and then again on Saturday, February 10, 2007 with a start time of 10:00 p.m. going until Sunday February 11, 2007, 8:00 a.m. If you can help with any of these events, I will have a sign up sheet available at our next meeting. Please sign up and state the times you will be able to participate.

The other item that we need to start working on is recruiting new 4th degree candidates for the exemplification in March. All 3rd degree Knights with at least 1 year of membership in the Knights are eligible. Note: You don't have to be a 3rd degree member of the Knights of Columbus for a year, you only have to be a member of the Knights of Columbus for one year. So for example; you could be a 1st degree member for a year then take your 2nd and 3rd degree in February 2007 and still take your 4th degree in March 2007. If the Knight only has 6 months of service and is a 3rd degree Knight before the March exemplification, we can get him an exception. So please recruit.
